

Introduction to NCCCWC Headquarters “B367 Fundraising Plan”

- Respond to Monthly Offerings as Soon as Possible Without Missing Out!

May peace and joy in our Lord be with you in the new year! Since 1973, under the NCCCWC ministry, many overseas Chinese students or visitors who passed through the Midwest region have heard God’s true gospel due to spreading the Word of the Bible, have reconciled with God, and are moving toward the mission, which is to “Learn and Act on the Lord’s Words, Be the Lord’s Disciples, Revive the Lord’s Work, and Undertake the Lord’s Commission.” If every Chinese continues to be guided under this mission in depth after being saved, the result will bring a greater impact in the Midwest, America, and every part of the world. Currently, in the Midwest, there are approximately 120 Bible study groups, fellowships and churches loosely spread out in campuses and cities, which are in need of nurturing and establishing.

Currently, NCCCWC has three major projects in progress: 1) Training Disciples—making disciples and enabling them to make disciples. 2) Strengthening NCCCWC—strengthening NCCCWC to become a comprehensive organization to preach the Word of God and support the mission in sending out disciples.

3) Undertaking the Lord’s Commission—encouraging disciples of Christ to build up local churches, and as churches build up NCCCWC.

Beginning in 1995, with a mission in “Letting the Christ Commission Be Rooted in the Midwest,” under the Lord’s guidance, NCCCWC understood that by completing the purchase of the headquarters will stabilize the development of the NCCCWC ministries, reach the mission, and have positive impacts. Afterwards, under the Lord’s guidance, the coworkers sought to relocate its headquarters to Chicago, the central city in the 13 Midwestern states, in order to serve the four purposes: office, disciple training center, housing to receive disciples and for inventory storage. The plan was passed by the NCCCWC Board of Trustees and coworkers during the meetings in 2000. Since December 26, 2003, NCCCWC continues to receive offerings at conferences up until today.

Give thanks to the Lord for leading Reverend Abraham Hsueh, the NCCCWC General Secretary, and together with his coworkers, they began to search for a suitable house for headquarters near Jefferson Park in Chicago at the end of May 2005. Give thanks to the Lord for leading the 2006 Fundraising and Building Search Teams to finally locate a proper building for headquarters on March 6, 2007; \$420,000 was fundraised and reached within 4 months by special offerings, though, more than half came from interest- and non-interest loans.

Nevertheless, NCCCWC bought the headquarters before April 1, 2007 and held a service for Headquarters Thanksgiving Usage.

Later, it took NCCCWC five months to begin paying off the interest loan by fundraising special offerings and non-interest loans. Furthermore, in order to prepare to pay off the remaining non-interest loans beginning after 19 months, NCCCWC launched an “A519 Fundraising Plan” in September 2007. Give thanks to the Lord, through prayers and response by offerings, the plan ended at the end of the nineteenth month on March 31, 2009, as planned. From this experience, NCCCWC had completed the “A519 Fundraising Plan!” Praise the Lord!

Beginning on April 1, 2009, NCCCWC is now faced with a remaining loan of **\$318,218.00**, in which **\$4,749.97** of 1.5% in no-interest loan needs to be paid off each month in order to complete the purchase of headquarters. Even though the “A519 Fundraising Plan” had completed, **nevertheless, it is only enough to pay 25.05%, \$1,190.09, of the current monthly loan payment.**

Therefore, on April 1, 2009, NCCCWC launched a headquarters “B367 Fundraising Plan,” meaning that in the next 67 months, after a portion of the housing rental is deducted from the loan payment, a steady monthly offering of **\$3,000** will thus fulfill the payment in next month.

Currently, only a total of **\$1,025.00** monthly offerings were made to the “B367 Fundraising Plan.” May you or your unit continue, or begin, to respond by prayers and offerings before the 20th of each month—**by sending in your special offerings or making any change to your loan to the NCCCWC Finance Department as soon as possible—so that**

NCCCWC can fulfill its fundraising target by monthly offerings and pay off the loan without any delays! Thus, this will mean the purchase of the NCCCWC headquarters will be fully completed in the days to come.

Each month, NCCCWC will do the followings: on the 1st Day: mail in the loan payment. On the 5th Day: send out a newsletter; on the 20th Day: day to respond by offerings (a suggestion to send out on the 20th in order to make sure that the monthly offering for that month arrives on time as appointed); on the 22nd Day: remind the respondents; last day at the end of the month: close up on the report of the offerings on that day of the month.

The headquarters fundraising has begun, hereby reminding everyone to make special offerings or monthly offerings. For we should make every effort to support by monetary offerings so we can “store up treasures in heaven”:

- 1. Do not stand by, do not fall behind, and do not think you have too little to offer! For the Lord looks at those who put in efforts!**
- 2. Do not stop, for each month the Lord will provide anew!**
- 3. Do not wait, for the Lord will bless those who offer first by faith!**
- 4. Do not forget, for the Lord remembers those who give by special offerings.**
